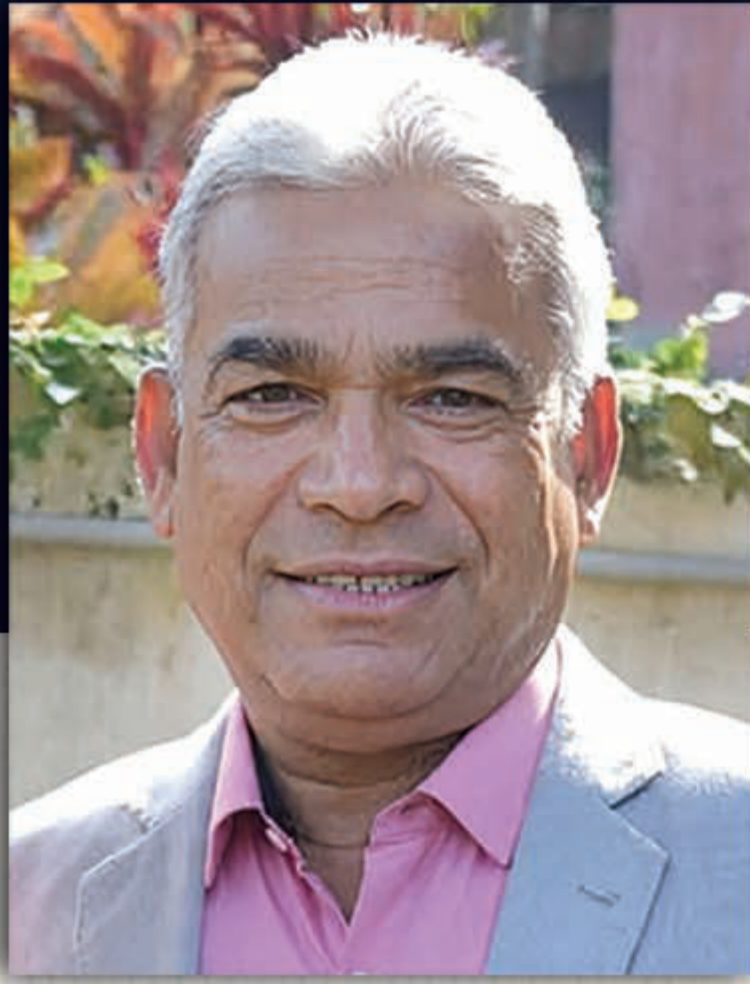

Nagaon University traces its roots to Nowgong College, established in 1944 and recognized as one of the oldest centers of higher education in Assam. The institution was elevated to a full-fledged state university through an Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly in 2023, thereby carrying forward a rich academic and cultural legacy associated with many distinguished personalities of the state.

While the transition to university status was formally initiated in 2023, its operational realization took concrete shape with the joining of the first Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Hitesh Deka, on 26th July 2025. Following the resumption of office by the Vice-Chancellor, the institution formally began functioning as a university, initiating administrative restructuring, academic expansion, and strategic planning in alignment with its new status.

Our objective is to create an atmosphere in which every student is encouraged to discover and develop his or her multifaceted talents.

The university is supported by highly dedicated and professionally accomplished faculty. LIBRARY

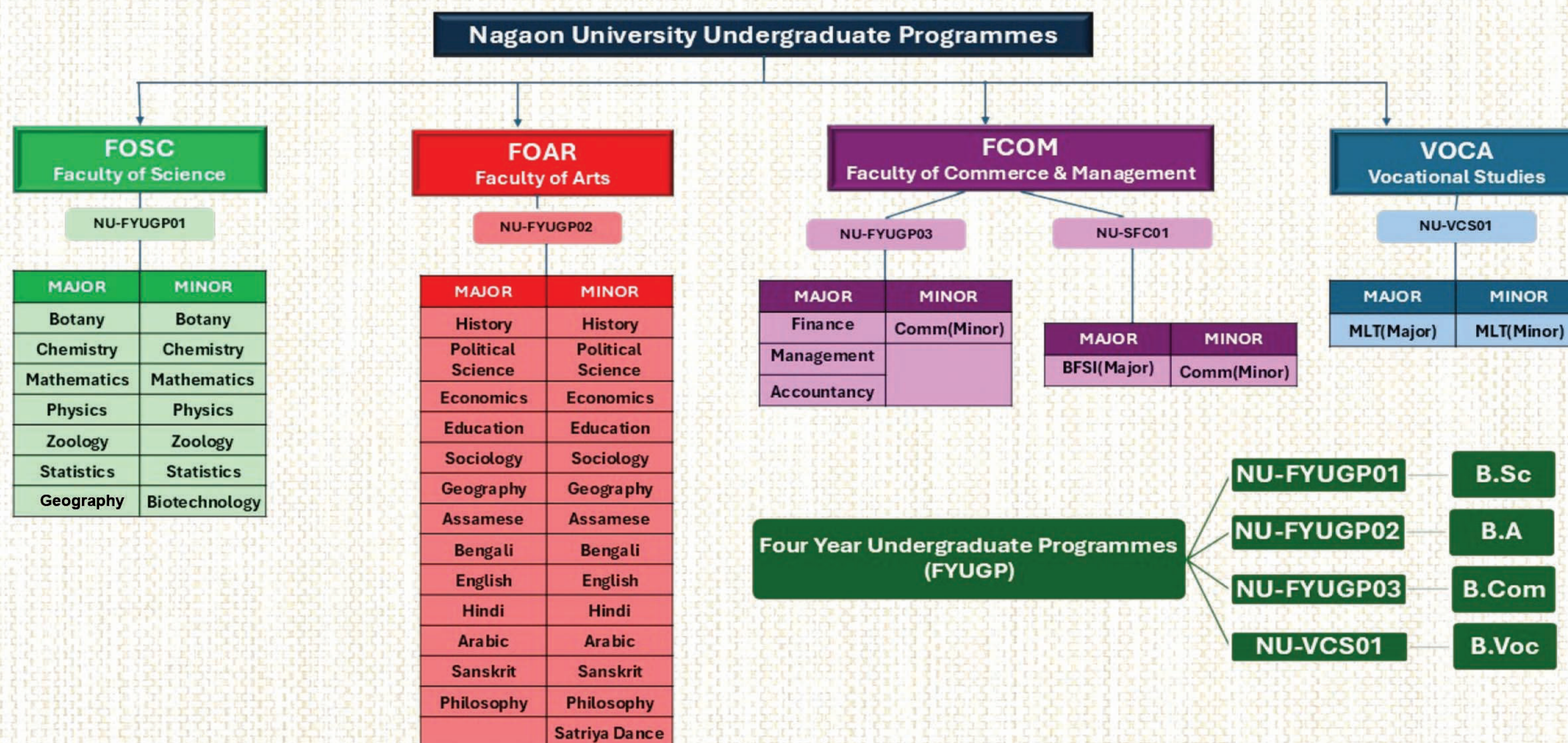


ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

Undergraduate Courses under NEP 2020 :

Nagaon University offers Four Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP) under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 with a flexible and multidisciplinary curriculum. Students can obtain a Certificate, Diploma, Degree, or Degree with Honours/Research depending on the duration of study and credits earned. The curriculum follows a semester and credit-based system with multiple entry and exit options.

Major & Minor Courses Offered



Students will need to choose 1 Major and 1 Minor within the same subject group (FOSC, FOAR, FCOM or VOCA) to be awarded either B.Sc., B.A., B.Com or B.Voc degree. Bachelor of Management Studies in BFSI is a 3-year degree programme.

PG PROGRAMME

Nagaon University offers PG admission in the following subjects: Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, Physics, Political Science, Sanskrit, Statistics, and Zoology. Admission to PG Programme is through Nagaon University Post Graduate Entrance Test (NU-PGET) Scores.

Ph.D PROGRAMME

Currently thirteen departments viz., Assamese, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Mathematics, Political Science, Philosophy, Physics, Sanskrit and Zoology are offering Ph.D Courses.

Candidates have to qualify Nagaon University Research Eligibility Test (NURET) followed by personal interview to get admitted into Ph.D Programme. Those who have qualified UGC-NET/ JRF or any other examination of equivalent standard are exempted from NURET and may appear directly for the interview.

ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDIT

The Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) is a UGC initiative that digitally stores the academic credits earned by students from various higher education institutions recognised by the government. Students at Nagaon University can register with the Academic Bank of Credit to have their credits stored and transferred, enabling greater flexibility in their academic journey under the NEP 2020 framework.

The ABC allows students to accumulate credits across institutions and programmes, facilitating multiple entry and exit options, re-entry into education, and credit transfer between universities. This system supports the vision of lifelong learning and academic mobility that is central to the National Education Policy 2020.

SPECIALIZED OFFERINGS

Dual Degree Programme :

ITEP — Integrated Teacher Education Programme (4 Years)

A dual-major four-year UG programme offering B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.Com. B.Ed. degrees, aligned with NEP 2020 and introduced by NCTE. Combines subject expertise with professional teacher training, pedagogy and classroom management.

BMS–BFSI Programme (In Collaboration with NISM/SEBI • 3 Years) :

A professional degree in Banking, Financial Services and Insurance, offered in partnership with NISM (a SEBI initiative). This course aims to develop managerial, financial and analytical skills for careers in banking, insurance, securities market and corporate sectors.

Dual Degree Programme through IGNOU :

Nagaon University has a regular study centre under the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), offering students opportunities to pursue dual degree programmes alongside their regular courses (Nagaon University Study Centre 04171). The IGNOU study centre provides undergraduate, postgraduate, diploma and certificate programmes in various disciplines. A student can study a programme of IGNOU along with his/her regular courses and can earn a dual degree.

The study centre of Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University (KKHSOU) at Nagaon University offers various undergraduate and postgraduate programmes through the open and distance learning mode.

The undergraduate programmes include B.A., B.Com, BBA, BCA. The postgraduate programmes offered include post graduate degree in Political Science, Education, Assamese, Economics, Hindi, History, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Sociology, Mathematics and Commerce.

The KKHSOU study centre provides flexible educational opportunities for students, working professionals and learners who wish to continue higher education through distance learning mode.

Sports :

Hostel Facilities :

University Uniform

Prescribed Uniform	
Boys	White shirt and black trousers (Jeans not allowed). Blue/Black sweater in winter.
Girls	White salwar kameez with peacock blue chunni and black cardigan/shawl. OR Muga/muga-coloured mekhela, white blouse and chaddar with blue-border, or white blouse with blue-border saree.

Note: Wearing the University uniform shall not be mandatory on Fridays. On that day, students may attend classes in decent attire other than the prescribed regular uniform.

Attendance :

Minimum 75% attendance in all subjects is compulsory for appearing in end-semester examinations. Exceptions may be considered for serious illness or accident with a medical certificate and leave application countersigned by parent/guardian.

Note to Parents & Code of Conduct :

Parents and guardians are requested to take note of the following code of conduct expected of all students of Nagaon University. Any violation of the code of conduct will be seriously viewed and punished as per university rules. Outside the campus, students must uphold the dignity and pride of the institution.

- Wear the approved university uniform on all working days except Friday.
- Carry your university ID card at all times inside the campus.
- Observe strict silence between class hours.
- MOBILE PHONES are prohibited inside the university campus.
